<b>Decision made:</b>	To implement a temporary suspension of non-essential market trader activity in Hereford City Centre with effective from 5 November 2020, with removal of this suspension to be determined by an authorised council officer when appropriate, in line with central government advice .
<b>Reasons for decision:</b>	Government advice has stated that from 5 November 2020 that markets could continue if they were offering essential items.
