Traffic Management Advisor, West Mercia Police	<p>I refer to your e-mail and attached letter dated 18th December 2019 seeking West Mercia Police's views in respect of the proposal to introduce a 30mph speed limit in Brierley as shown on the drawing ref "3409 Brierley Existing and Proposed speed Limits" accompanying the e-mail.</p> <p>I have examined the plans and visited the area on Wednesday 18th December to see it first hand. I can confirm that I have no objections to the proposal, though I am inclined to agree with your comments that as existing vehicle speeds are already at a level we would expect to see in a 30mph limit it is debatable as to the overall effect and benefit of the time & costs of raising a TRO to introduce a speed limit at this location.</p>
