	Responsibility for monitoring the project and managing expenditure within the total spend budget is to be with the Capital Senior Project Manager.

Reasons for decision:	There is a need to engage an external provider in order to progress the design and statutory approvals, and to provide professional support through the construction phase. A competitive procurement exercise was undertaken in accordance with Council procurement procedures. The tender return from Berrys was the most favourable when assessed against quality and cost criteria.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/ equality considerations:	There is risk that once on site, further work is identified when the design works commence which was not previously apparent. A contingency has been allowed within the total budget of £77,000 to cover unforeseen elements once the design works commence. Should this contingency be insufficient then a further officer decision would be required.
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	Not to appoint. This option is not recommended. The preferred supplier has been identified following a competitive tendering process. Not to appoint would prevent any further progress in defining the scheme and would lead to a failure to deliver the improvements which the Council has committed to.
