	The specification was approved in November by the councils building surveyor and mechanical engineer.
	The sports club to date have been paid £161,771.70 this amount of £11,228.30 is the final payment and will make the total of £173k.
	A copy of the invoices and valuation to date have been provided.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/ equality considerations:	There is a risk that the cost of reinstatement will be over the approved budget. The club have got a fully costed budget, there are works which are improvements which have been funded by external funding. There are further improvement works which are planned in phases to allow for external funding to be found.
	There is a risk that the works will not be up to the desired regulatory and statutory requirements. The sports club have a defined project team in place to oversee the works and the contractors are appropriately qualified to undertake the works.
