Decision made:	Award contract to Daisy to the value of £56,630 and ComputaCentre to the value of £22,975.20 (excluding VAT) to migrate the council's corporate document management systems.
Reasons for decision:	The technology (hardware and software support) that underpins the council's document management system is approaching end of life and thus needs to be moved on to supported platforms and technologies.  This includes:  • Moving data from the EMC Centera storage (at end of mainline hardware support) to the new hardware,  • Migration from server 2008 (extended support ends 2022) to 2019 (supportable to 2029)  • Conversion of data from CAS to S3 format. The conversion to S3 format also enables the council to move to cloud storage at a later date, if required, in line with the council digital strategy 2018-23  The document management system is a solution development and supported by Daisy. ComputaCentre have existing expertise in the migration of data from CAS to S3 format.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:  Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	The technology underpinning the council's document management system has or is approaching end of life, its continued use puts the system at risk from software vulnerabilities and both software / hardware.  Do nothing - this was not the preferred option due to the increasing risk to the council.
