Consultation:	A communication plan will be implemented to inform and liaise with key stakeholders affected by these closures and the resting diversions. This will include local residents, businesses, Parish Councils and local ward members				
Decision made:	To authorise the making of a Temporary Road Closure Order served under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to require a temporary closure on the road mentioned in Schedule 1, planned to be effective commencing on the 29 th of November 2021.				
Reasons for decision:	To enable Gigaclear to carry out rural fibre installation works within the highway, as highway authority, consider the closure of the road is required due to the likelihood of danger to highway users while the said works are being carried out.				
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/ equality considerations:	Localised disruption on highway network which will be mitigated using diversion route signage and closure period to be kept at shortest possible duration. Pedestrian access to premises affected by this closure will be maintained.				
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	Not to introduce a temporary closure of the road; but there would then be operational difficulties in the said works being carried out, and/or would result in a longer period of disruption. In addition, there would be a greater risk to users of the highway and possible claims against the highway authority as a result.
