Consultation:	The works promoter will carry out a letter drop at least 2 weeks prior to works commencing to inform and liaise with local residents and businesses likely to be affected by these works. Advance notice boards will also be displayed at the location of works to provide advance notice of the works.
Decision made:	To authorise the making of a Temporary Parking Restriction Order served under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to require a temporary parking restriction on the U91229, Hatton Gardens Industrial Estate, Kington, outside Paragon Laundry, planned to be effective for a period of 5 days commencing on the 19 <sup>th</sup> January 2022.
Reasons for decision:	To enable Cadent Gas to carry out service disconnection works within the highway, for which purpose the Council, as highway authority, consider the parking restriction of the road is required due to the likelihood of danger to highway users while the said works are being carried out.
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	Not to introduce a temporary parking restriction on the road; but there would then be operational difficulties in the said works being carried out, and/or would result in a longer period of disruption. In addition, there would be a greater risk to users of the highway and possible claims against the highway authority as a result.
