

Minimum Income Guarantee (MIG) 2022/23

- The Department for Health and Social Care (DHSC) publishes MIG rates annually
- The proposed MIG to be used by Herefordshire Council is based on Income support or Pension Credit allowances and premiums with an additional 25% buffer.
- The minimum income guarantee for a person living with a partner is based on half the couple rate.
