

Change to the arrangements for public speaking in respect of application 214046 -

Proposed change of use of land, as an aerodrome consisting of the continued use of a grass airstrip, re-use of an existing barn as hangarage and for maintenance and associated landscaping at LAND AT LYDE COURT, LYDE CROSS, HEREFORD, HEREFORDSHIRE, HR1 3AE

Following consultation with the Chairman of the planning and regulatory committee and noting the exceptional circumstances involved in application 214046 – Land at Lyde Court, a change to the number of speakers and the time for public speaking has been agreed. The application is exceptional with respect to the number of parish councils that have been consulted during the consultation period for the application.

Those parish councils, consulted as part of the application, and that have made enquiries to speak will be allowed to address the committee at the meeting on Wednesday 29 June up to a maximum of nine minutes. Nine minutes will be the total time allowable for all parish councils registered to speak to address the committee.

After the deadline for registration to speak has expired (10:00 a.m. Monday 27 June), the indicative period of time each parish council has to address the committee will be confirmed (the nine minutes will be divided equally among those parish councils seeking to register); if desired, it will be open to those parish councils registered to speak to agree allocations of time between them up to a maximum of nine minutes.

To ensure fairness and balance the total time allocated to the parish councils to speak will also be provided to objectors and supporters to the application who register to speak at the meeting; multiple speakers in objection and support will also be allowed to speak at the meeting. Objectors and supporters will have up to nine minutes to address the committee.
