We refer to your recent application as detailed above, which was received on GOV.UK on 23 June 2022 and by the Licensing Authority on the 24 June 2022

The Licensing Authority is unable to accept your application for the reasons shown below:

The Right to Work in the UK document is corrupted	X
The consent form is incorrect – the consent is not signed by the current premises licence holder	X
The premises licence (or relevant parts) are not enclosed – if you cannot enclose this, please give a reason why on the amended application	Х
The premises licence is currently suspended, therefore the authority cannot accept any application until the suspension has been lifted	Х

Following your application, we now have reason to believe that this premise is no longer under the control of the licence holder and designated premises supervisor Mrs Rajuinder Kaur as specified on the premises licence. I must emphasise that Section 19 of the Licensing Act 2003 sets out the Mandatory condition where a licence authorises the supply of alcohol:

That no supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence –

• At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence,

Or

• At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.



You are advised that Section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003 makes it an offence for a premise to be used for any licensable activity otherwise than under and in accordance with an authorisation subject to which the licence is held. Any person found guilty of an offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or an unlimited fine, or both.

In line with this Authority's Policy, I must advise you that should you choose to operate outside your authorisation, we may take enforcement action against you.
