<b>Reasons for decision:</b>	<p>Pupil numbers at the school have been increasing in recent years making it difficult to provide sufficient purposeful space for children to use at break times. The school are encouraging children to be as active as possible during breaks and put on a range of additional activities to encourage this, however they do not have sufficient play equipment to operate safely.</p>		
<b>Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:</b>	<p>Potential risks in delivery with material lead in times to ensure delivery of the project for the start of the new term. However due to the limited access to the Nursery area during term time, the project will look to commence on the 24<sup>th</sup> October 2022.</p>		
<b>Details of any alternative options considered and</b>	<p>A wider Nursery outdoor area redevelopment was considered however after a procurement exercise the project was rejected due to affordability and current available budgets.</p>
