| Decision made: | To accept a Change Control Request from Beryl to implement a price increase on Pay As You Go charges on e-bikes only . Price increase from 10p to 12p per minute. The cost of unlocking the bike is unchanged at £1 |
| Reasons for decision: | Beryl cited the impact of rising energy, supplier and staff costs as key drivers for the increase. To minimise the impact on users, Minute bundles will remain at the current price as will all pedal bike charges. Minute bundles provide the best value for riders and they will be promoted in-app to ensure users understand the available saving of switching away from PAYG. |
| Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations: | There will be no revenue generation for the Council and no costs incurred. |
| Details of any alternative options considered and rejected: | The council could refuse the request to increase the price but recognising the validity of the request from the supplier and the price increases that Beryl face this could undermine the quality of the service provided. |
