	who are nevertheless struggling due to the increased cost of living.
	The council already operates an application scheme for people requiring support
	in an emergency through its Local Welfare Provision (LWP) service. Utilising this
	funding enables the LWP service and eligibility criteria for emergency support to
	be enhanced, by providing additional staff resources to assess and administer
	applications and distribute the voucher payments.

	support to meet crucial needs of a person or household experiencing financial
	hardship resulting in them struggling to feed themselves or their family, heat
