	Due to Brexit and the Covid pandemic, and the related supply chain issues, inflation has increased the cost of building materials and therefore, in order to undertake these works, further budget is required.
	The allocated estimated budget of £55,000, will need to be supplemented from the programme contingency fund to the £130,000 required. Based on tendered costs for other works across the various projects once sufficient underspend has been confirmed in order to fund works from the contingency budget.
