Decision made:	To issue formal community protection notice in accordance with Section 43 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014
Reasons for decision:	Complaint was received regarding antisocial behaviour of the owner in that building type items are being stored on the car park spaces and in the rear garden which is having a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality, is of a persistent or continuing nature; and be unreasonable. A community protection warning was issued giving the owner the opportunity to address the issues, but the owner has not addressed any of the issues, therefore following the legislation process the next step is for the officer to issue the community protection notice.
