In principle I have no objections to this application and note it is part of a wider re-development of the retail site into a Morrison's Daily.

The premises are situated quite close to The Co-Op and Aldi stores which already supply alcohol up to 10pm at night therefore the sale of alcohol in the evenings has been ongoing for a number of years.

In terms of Public Safety and Public Nuisance I do have some reservations about this application hours of business selling alcohol to 2300 hrs seven days a week - an extra hour.

I note the references to CCTV and Challenge 25 Scheme. If appropriate it would be good if the store were also part of the HAND pub watch scheme as well?

The retail store lies within the Public Spaces Protection Order for no alcohol consumption in the town centre. How will conforming with this order be addressed by the applicant, or is that not a material consideration?
