- Our Chair, Sir David Henshaw, hosted the recent fourth river pollution summit on 18 March on behalf of our First Minister Mark Drakeford and Minister for Climate Change Julie James.
- 22 out of 29 permits on WWTW in Wye catchment now issued through the review of permits work. We have published on our web site the permits which have been varied – [Natural Resources Wales / Phosphorus limits on environmental permits for waste water treatment work discharges](#)
- Our new agriculture team have made a good start and inspected 8 high risk farms in the Wye catchment. High risk activities include farms producing, storing, or using high levels of organic manures which includes digestate, biosolids and other wastes recovered to land.
