decision:	Winforton Community Hall will no longer be used and the electorate will now go to Whitney-on-Wye Village Hall which was used before the 2019 review but had availability issues at that time. It is a more suitable venue. Pentwyn Court is no longer suitable to use as a polling station so we have moved the electorate to Redhill Residents Association (which is already used as a polling station) to be part of a dual polling station. Since Electoral Services are moving the electorate into polling stations already in existence or that have been in use before, they have been thoroughly reviewed during or just prior to the last polling station review in 2019.

All health and safety is covered in the 2019 polling station review undertaken by Electoral Services. It is a legal requirement under schedule A1 of the Representation of the People Act 1983 for sufficient polling places to be identified.
