	Decision - To approve the 2024/25 budget and associated Medium Term Financial Strategy and Treasury Management Strategy.
	Delivery of the £250k of funding is proposed to be through Parish Lengthsman contract variation agreements, purchase orders or through the supply of materials only, which are permissible under the Council's Contract Procedure Rules.
Ward:	Countywide.
Consultation:	Town and Parish Councils were invited to provide submissions for improvement works on Public Rights of Way in May 2024.
Decision made:	To enter into Parish Lengthsman contract variation agreements with 18 Town and Parish Councils, to provide labour only purchase orders for 2 Town and Parish Councils, to supply materials only to 4 Town and Parish Councils as listed in Appendix 1, and to increase a previous agreement with Little Birch Parish Council by a further £2,250 due to an administrative error so as to deliver £83,063.53 of improvement works on the Public Rights of Way network, as set out in this report, and within a total value of £25k per Town and Parish Council in order to be permissible as a direct award under the Contract Procedure Rules.
	(This Record of Officer Decision is further to a previous Record of Officer Decision of July 2024 to enter into Parish Lengthsman contract variation agreements with 34 Town and Parish Councils in order to deliver £83,602.45 of improvement works on the Public Rights of Way network).
Reasons for decision:	Working with parishes on locally important maintenance, including Public Rights of Way, forms part of the objective to 'Expand and maintain the transport infrastructure network in a sustainable way and improve connectivity across the county' in the Council's Delivery Plan 2024/25.
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sub of S PRO and 6.2 Sul loc des	May 2024, Town and Parish Councils were invited to provide bmissions for the £250k of grant funding for works on the Public Rights Way network. The funding was made available for replacement of minor town assets such as stiles, finger posts and gates, but also allowed Town d Parish Councils to identify other bespoke assets and bridges under 2m for improvement. bmissions were invited by 1 st July 2024 and provided details of the cation (what3words) of each asset including photographs, a short escription of the work required and a cost estimate, using the cost of irchase to the Council.
