Decision made:	To award the Resurfacing Works, Works Orders 1 and 2 contract to Tarmac Trading using the councils NEC 4 Framework Agreement, up to the value of £3,031,553.50. The works identified are the resurfacing programme on various A, B, C and U roads across the county.
Reasons for decision:	In order to deliver the investment, as set out in the decision reports above. The works associated with the contract are resurfacing the network on a prioritisation criteria based on condition and need.
Equality Considerations	As a result of the selection of roads for investment as part of this decision is considered to have a positive impact on the protected characteristics of Age and Disability. The investment set out in this report is considered to have a neutral impact on the other protected characteristics.

Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/ Finance: equality considerations: Under the selection process for the framework, Officers have used the quotation information provided which shows that the total of the prices of Tarmac Trading Ltd is likely to be significantly lower than the other Suppliers on the Framework based upon the quotation information submitted within the framework tender and therefore this Supplier gives the council good value for money. A total budget of £6.25million has been allocated to the 2024/25 project, funded through Herefordshire Councils Capital Programme. The funding is bringing together the various budgets with the appropriate governance.
