

<u>Licensing Authority Representation</u> <u>Trilogy</u> 20.03.2025

I am an officer authorised under the Licensing Act 2003.

I refer to the application made for a variation of a premises licence in respect of Trilogy, Blueschool Street, Hereford.

It is noted the application states; The current Operating Schedule robustly promotes the Licensing Objectives, so no changes are proposed and the conditions

A new set of plans with the variation have also been submitted, which do not include the highlighted area of Botanic (as per current plans dated 20.08.2024), therefore the condition (under the Prevention of Crime & Disorder objective), *The premises use pet glassware for wines, spirits and draught beer throughout the premises, except the Botanic bar (area shaded in yellow on the plan submitted 20/08/2024) where glass vessels can be used up to 0100hrs would not be enforceable (due to the plans forming part of the licence).*

The Licensing Authority object to this variation application, however they wish the following attached plan to be added to the licence to promote the licensing objectives and also amend an existing condition in relation to the SIA door staff requirement

The Prevention of Crime and Disorder

Current condition reads:

The use of standard glass will be permitted within the cocktail bar (currently called Botanic). Where there is to be any transfer of customer between the cocktail bar and the night club (currently called Trilogy) through internal doors, then the cocktail bar shall only supply alcohol, in pet glassware from 2245 hours until the end of licensable activities. Standard glasses shall not be permitted within the night club and to ensure this there shall be in place a SIA Door person in the doorway between the cocktail bar and the club.

Proposed condition:

The use of standard glass will be permitted within the cocktail bar (currently called Botanic). Where there is to be any transfer of customer between the cocktail bar and the night club (currently called Trilogy) through internal doors, then the cocktail bar shall only supply alcohol, in pet glassware from 2245 hours until the end of licensable activities. Standard glasses shall not be permitted within the night club and to ensure this there shall be in place a SIA Door person in the doorway between the cocktail bar and the club, marked in pink on the plan dated 20.03.2025.

If the applicant agrees to the proposed condition and plan, then the Licensing Authority will withdraw their objection
