Decision made:	To award a contract (Works Order 21) to Tarmac Trading Ltd using the			
	Council's NEC 4 Framework Agreement, up to the value of £891,010.16			
	with an approved contingency of 10% to the value of £89,101.01.			
	The works identified are the resurfacing programme on various A and B			
	roads across the county, as shown within Appendix 1.			
Reasons for decision:	In order to deliver the investment, as set out in the decision reports			
	above. The works associated with the contract are resurfacing the			
	network on a prioritisation criteria based on condition and need.

	decision is considered to have a positive impact on the protected

	A total budget of £10million has been allocated to the 2025/26 project, funded through Herefordshire Councils Capital Programme. The budget allocation utilised is identified below.  Of the £10million budget, £3,263,158.61 has already been committed for the delivery of resurfacing works and as a result of this decision, a further £891,010.16 will be committed as a result of this decision
