pupils, or one visit and
one visitor.

school must attend
an RE conference or
an RE hub meeting.

3

You must arrange an RE
day or an RE event.
Or
You must enter a
competition to do with
RE (such as Spirited
Arts or Spirited Poetry).

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Silver Award

1

You must take a group of your pupils to visit two places of worship, or invite two visitors with religious or non-religious worldviews into your school; or one visit and one visitor. Provide a write-up of the events, including pupil responses to show the impact.

2

Someone from your school must attend at least two RE CPD events (e.g. Glos summer conference, local RE hub meetings, NATRE's 'Strictly RE' conference) and provide a write-up to show how the training has had an impact on your practice.

3

You must arrange an RE day or an RE event *OR* enter a competition to do with RE (such as Spirited Arts or Spirited Poetry). You must provide a commentary on the events or the entries, including pupil responses to demonstrate impact.

The **RE**action Award is a project initiated and administered by Gloucestershire Standing Advisory Council on Religious Education (SACRE).

SACREs are independent bodies that consider and advise on the provision of Religious Education in the area under the jurisdiction of their Local Authority; they are empowered to require a review of the locally agreed syllabus for Religious Education.

Gloucestershire SACRE seeks to support local schools through its agreed syllabus, annual conferences and support for local network groups.

It works closely with the Diocese of Gloucester, RE Today Services and the National Association of Teachers of RE (NATRE).

The Gloucestershire REaction Award is based on the WIRE Award devised by Bristol and South Gloucestershire SACREs.



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
