Reasons for decision:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request received from National Grid to dig a trench and lay underground HV cable to replace the existing overground supply as part of a roll-out of network improvements at schools. • This will also serve the local community and help improve supply in the area. • All of the existing poles and stays will be removed. • The existing transformer will be removed from the school site.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The position of the trench will not impede the operation of the school. • National Grid will carry out the work during a period of school holidays to minimize disruption. • National Grid will reinstate disturbed land which is on the car parking area. • A standard wayleave fee will be paid by National Grid. • The agreement may be ended by either party upon 12 months' written notice.
