ABBREVIATION	MEANING	EXPLANATION
R.S.I.	Rough Sleeping Initiative	a five-year revenue funding grant provided by central Government to Local Authorities.
Everyone In	Accommodation plan	Accommodation funded by central Government to accommodate all rough sleepers during COVID-19 Pandemic.
BRAVE	Building Resilience Against Endemic Vulnerabilities	Herefordshire intervention program to reduce the numbers of rough sleepers and mitigate the impact of complex multiple difficulties on rough sleepers.
C.M.D.	Complex Multiple Difficulties	Term used to describe the impact of a combination of impacts caused by trauma linked to the impact mental ill health, poor physical health, poverty, homelessness and / or interactions with the Criminal Justice System.
C.J.S.	Criminal Justice System	Combined term to reflect Police, Courts, Judiciary, Prison and Probation services.
	Accommodations	WNS – 18 bed Winter night shelter (14 male, 4 female) + 4 Emergency Accommodation pods. WXR – 12 units of supported accommodation HSH – 13 units of supported accommodation BFS (1) – 6 units of semi-supported accommodation SHAP – 15 units of one bed semi-support accommodation NZH – 8 units semi-support accommodation (now discontinued) NTR (1) – 4 units of semi-support accommodation NTR (2) – 12 units of semi-support accommodation BFS (2) – 10 units of semi-supported accommodation (in development) JHB – 28 units of semi-supported accommodation (in development)
S.H.A.P.	Single Homeless Accommodation Program	Three-year Capital and revenue funding grant provided by central Government to Local Authorities.
L.H.A.F.	Local Area Housing Fund	Capital and revenue funding grant provided by central Government to Local Authorities to deliver homes for Ukrainians, Syrians and Afghans.

T.I.A.	Trauma Informed Approach	A specific approach to working with people that takes account of how past trauma has shaped a persons life
A.C.E.	Adverse Childhood Trauma	Terms used to collectively describe the trauma faced by under 17 year olds when a child – encompasses (but not limited too) – death, abuse (in all forms) relationship breakdown, imprisonment of parent / sibling, bullying, ill health, domestic violence / abuse.
H.H.H.N.A.	Herefordshire Homeless Health Needs Audit	An assessment tool developed by Homeless Link (Homeless Link) to capture health needs data from people who are homeless. Helps to assess the impact of homelessness and drive system change within organisation’s delivering services.
Housing First		(Housing First is a model of housing that provides accommodation with or without support – see Housing First: tackling homelessness for those with complex needs - House of Commons Library for more details)
C.V.F.S.	Community Voluntary Faith sector	The collective term for the wider voluntary sector that support the delivery of services.
AfEO	Accommodation for Ex-Offenders	Accommodation funded by central Government to spot rent accommodate for offenders being released from Prison – not able to be used in Herefordshire as rental costs in county to high.
CAS	Community Access Scheme	Accommodation funded by central Government to spot rent accommodate for offenders being released from Prison – came in three waves 1, 2, 3. No accommodation in Herefordshire due to affordability factor – delivered by Probation Service.
