Decision title:	Highways Act 1980 Application for an amendment to the List Of Streets – Dinedor Camp Road

Consultation:	As part of the process undertaken, the Parish Council was consulted.
Decision made:	THAT: a) The road identified on the plan at Appendix A is added to the List Of Streets as an Unclassified Road
Reasons for decision:	Herefordshire Council has a legal duty under section 36 of the Highways Act 1980 to maintain a list of streets that are highways maintainable at public expense, and assesses any claims that an existing route should be considered a highway maintainable at public expense using its published Highway Records Protocol - herefordshire council highway records protocol.pdf An application was made under the Highway Records Protocol, together with supporting evidence, for the inclusion of Dinedor Camp Road on the List Of Streets. Herefordshire Council commissioned Robin Carr Associates to assess the evidence contained in both the application and any other publicly available records, and following extensive research a recommendation was made that evidence supported adding the road to the list of streets as a public vehicular highway. With regard to the exact status of the road, it is felt that the exemption under NERC for a route carrying predominantly vehicular traffic (as referenced in 8.15 of the report) should apply given the routes history and usage, i.e. the predominant public usage of the route is considered to have been in motorised vehicles in the five years predating the 2006 Act.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	Finance: The costs associated with commissioning the report, along with repairing defects in the route will be met through current capital and revenue service budgets. Legal: As surveying authority for Rights of Way, Herefordshire Council has a duty under section 36 of the Highways Act 1980 to keep the List Of Streets maintainable at public expense up to date.
Details of any alternative options considered and	Where evidence has been discovered showing the existence of a public highway that is not recorded on the List Of Streets maintainable at public expense, the Council is required to make such amendments to the List Of Streets as appear to
