Purpose

1. To consider the layout of the 'common application form' to be used for the coordinated secondary transfer arrangement for September 2006 (SA1), which was deferred from the Forums last meeting.

2. Co-ordinated Secondary Transfer Scheme

2. Herefordshire LEA introduced the Co-ordinated Secondary Transfer Scheme from September 2004. As required by Statutory Instrument 2002/2004 and the Code of Practice on School Admissions, the Council produced a common application form covering all community and voluntary aided schools. The SA1 form enables all parents to express at least 3 preferences, which could include schools within or beyond the Herefordshire area.
3. The SA1 form has been amended to reflect the decision of Cabinet on 14 July 2005 regarding denominational transport.

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Local Admission Forum approves the format and contents of the 'common application form' for secondary education for the year September 2006.
