Members of the Licensing Panel of the Council's Regulatory Committee considered the above application, full details of which appeared before the Members in their agenda and the background papers.

Prior to making their decision, the Members heard from Mr. Wormald, the Applicant's Legal Advisor, and Sergeant Edwards, representing West Mercia Police Authority.

Having carefully considered those matters brought before them, the Committee were of the opinion that the application should be **granted subject** to the conditions appearing below. In reaching their decision, the Members had full regard to both the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 and the Council's Licensing Policy. The Members imposed conditions in order to promote the four licensing objectives, namely the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm.

- The DPS will use best endeavours to ensure that open containers are not removed from the premises, save and except for consumption within the beer garden and other outdoor areas attached to the premises.
- At least two SIA registered door staff should be present on the premises on Friday or Saturday nights commencing at 2000 hours when the premise is to be open after midnight.
- No person shall be permitted in the beer garden between the hours of 11.30 pm and 7.00 am on any day.
- The Licensing Authority to be issued with copies of J.D. Wetherspoon's 'Overview of Operations' and 'Approach to Responsible Drinking' documents when updated or amended.
