Members of the Licensing Panel of the Council's Regulatory Committee considered the above application, full details of which appeared before the Members in their agenda and the background papers.

Prior to making their decision, the Members heard from Mr. Neal, the Applicant, and Miss Woodland, the Environmental Health Officer, as well as Mr. Simmons, Mr. Ternouth, and Mr. Fraser, three of the local residents who had raised objections to the application.

Having carefully considered those matters brought before them, the Committee were of the opinion that the application should be **granted subject** to the conditions appearing below. In reaching their decision, the Members had full regard to both the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 and the Council's Licensing Policy. The Members imposed conditions in order to promote the four licensing objectives, namely the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm.

CONDITIONS

The application was granted in respect of the hours of operation of the licensable activities described in the box above together with the following conditions

- The mandatory conditions of The Licensing Act 2003.

PUBLIC NUISANCE

- The entertainment venue (disco and bar facility) hereby licensed shall be for the exclusive use of persons employed by S & A Davies at Brook Farm, Marden
- All external doors to the venue shall be kept closed after 20:00 hours except for access or egress
- Noise from music entertainment provided at the premises shall be inaudible at the nearest noise sensitive dwelling.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- The maximum number of persons on the premises at any time shall not exceed **280**
- Systems in place to control persons entering the venue shall be adequately maintained and in use each time entertainment is provided at the premises to prevent overcrowding and minimise the likelihood of disturbance.
- A risk assessment for the entertainment area shall be recorded and maintained. Adequate systems shall be in place to ensure the actions (and precautions) identified in the risk assessment are effectively implemented.

ADDITIONAL CONDITION

- Subject to the requirements of Planning Control, a double door entrance system be erected by 31st December, 2006.
