Once completed, each Councillor's Register of Interests form should be sent to the monitoring officer Herefordshire Council, Governance and Democratic Services, 33-35 Union Street, St Peters Square Hereford, HR1 2HX.

- In order to comply with the relevant Council's code of conduct, a Member or Co-opted Member must register their disclosable pecuniary interests (DPI's) now described as schedule 1 interests and schedule 2 interests with Herefordshire Council's Monitoring Officer within 28 days of the date of their election, re-election or co-option and also once a member becomes aware that they have an interest or a change has occurred.

 Failure to register a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest (DPI), or providing false or misleading 1
- 2 information regarding a DPI, is a criminal offence under section 34 of the Localism Act 2011 A member who is found guilty of such an offence is liable on summary conviction to an unlimited fine and disqualification from being or becoming a member of any authority for up to five years. If you cease to have an interest that you have previously registered, please re-submit an updain of the date the amendments are made is acceptable
